Agree with the three classifications. Presumed human reproductive toxicant for effects on fertility and development, insufficient data for effects via lactation.
There are some additional manuscripts discussing the effects of hydroxyurea on fertility; however, the cited references do an adequate job and additional references will not provide new information.
None
