Thank you and your colleagues dr. T. Connor and dr L. Rojanasakul for accepting the invitation to comment on the draft report 'Adriamycin', which was published for public review in June 2014 by the Dutch Expert Committee on Occupational Safety (DECOS) of the Health Council of the Netherlands.

The Committee highly appreciates the detailed comments presented by the NIOSH reviewers. The Committee has incorporated quite a number of the recommended references in its final report. Especially the studies regarding the occupational exposure of adriamycin were considered important (Pieri et al., Kauppinen et al.) The Committee has shown some reluctance to elaborate on studies that were too obviously concerned with therapeutic and clinical aspects of adriamycin and made a selection from the recommended studies. Most of the studies on the genotoxic mechanisms were included as reference, but the Committee did not choose for a detailed discussion in the report.

In the Annex to this letter the responses by DECOS to all recommendations made by NIOSH are specified.
